December 1, 2015

Wine Country RV Resort, Paso Robles, CA

The meeting was called to order by President Paul Springer at 1:01 P.M.

Board Members present: President - Paul Springer, 1st Vice-President - John Wright, 2nd Vice-President - LeRoy Davis, Secretary - Carol Wright, Treasurer - Dale Johnson, National Director - Jamie Strahan, Chapter Director - Bob Wyrick, Chapter Director - Dick Perry, Membership Chairman - Sharon Rendall, Wagon Master - Denny Wheeler, Assistant Wagon Master - Kerry Ray.

A quorum of rigs was present.

Paul lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Roger Rendall and seconded by Denny Wheeler to accept the posted Treasurer's report. Motion passed.

Committee Reports:

Membership: Sharon Rendall reported that the current membership stands at 108 rigs. There are no new members since the last Rally. Dues for 2016 are due. \$18 for the year.

<u>Historian:</u> Donna Brodt reported she has put together an album of photos from past Rallys. It's available for viewing.

<u>Photographer</u>: John Stocksdale reminded the Trail Bosses they are to find/appoint a person to act as photographer for all rallies he does not attend. The pictures can be sent to him via email.

<u>Indio:</u> Roger Rendall asked for more help for driving the carts. Sign up low. 65 drivers are needed. Another club may help.

<u>Wagon Master</u>: Denny Wheeler said the sign up deadline for Tombstone is approaching. Rally date is March 1^{st} and out on the 6^{th} \$27. per night. No one has signed up for being a Trail Boss for Bakersfield so it is cancelled. The Colombia rally will be moved to the April date.

<u>National Director</u>: Dick Gibbs reported that the overall sign up for Indio is low. He asked the members to please participate. He also asked our Club to reconsider the decision to not participate in the parade. They have added bus trips and more activities. The FMCA Western Region Board needs support. Char Gibbs also stated she needs models for the Lady's Tea.

New Business

Indio Rally: Court Warren reminded the group to register for Indio by December 15th. Only 11 rigs signed up so far. The separate deadline for signing up directly with FMCA is also close. Dates are January 3rd and out on the 10th. Electricity will be available the first day. Reminder, it's dry camping so fill your fresh water tank and empty your grey and black water tanks. Cost is now \$210 to FMCA. Some are going early and staying at Indian Waters.

<u>Number of Rallies:</u> Paul Springer reported that the Board has recommended changing the number of rallies from 10 per year to 8 per year. New dark months are June, July, August and November. Some discussion about no-host Rallies like done in the past at Jackson. Court Warred moved and Denny Wheeler seconded. The motion passed.

<u>Potential Rally Conflict:</u> Sylvia Burns brought up a potential conflict between the Mule Days Rally and the Bass Lake Rally. After discussion, it was decided to bring to the Board at a special meeting after this meeting.

<u>New Officers Nominating Committee:</u> It was announced that Lance and Judy Brown have accepted being Chairpersons for the New Officer's Nominating Committee. Election for all new officers except one Chapter Director will need to be filled for the 2017-2018 term.

<u>Rally Change</u>: Mike Carlie announced the October Rally scheduled for Death Valley had a poor response. It was suggested it to be changed to Borrego Springs about 60 miles south of Indio. He provided several brochures for review. The dates will be in on October 26th, out on the 30th. There is a parade and festival at that time. The RV park is surrounded by a 9 hole golf course and there is a 4 wheeler driving area. They need helpers.

<u>Dream Team:</u> Jamie Strachan reported on a new Dream Team made up of 6 couples who have been Trail Bosses and will help recruit and mentor new people to become Trail Bosses. Help with planning and executing a Rally.

<u>Coaster Clothing:</u> The group was reminded that official Coasters' clothing was available for purchase from Kerry Ray.

<u>New Officer's:</u> Two new officers were sworn in by Court Warren. Dick Perry will continue another term as Chapter Director. Howard Jones will fill in the remaining term as Assistant Wagon Master.

Birthdays and anniversaries were acknowledged.

Ida-Jean Woodruff moved to adjourn. Seconded by Mike Carle. Motion passed. The meeting ended at 2;46 P.M.

This is a great place to have a rally since there is so much to do in the area. The campground is owned and operated by Monterey County Parks and is on a hill overlooking the Mazda Laguna Seca Raceway.

<u>Directions</u>: Drive north on Hwy 101 toward Salinas. About 5 miles before Salinas take the Abbott Street exit on the **left** toward the town of Spreckles. Drive 2.19 miles on Abbott Street and turn **left** on Harris Road, about 2.75 miles. Harris road turns to the right and becomes Spreckles Boulevard. Drive about 1.65 miles on Spreckles Boulevard and merge onto Monterey Salinas Hwy/CA 68 via the ramp on the **left** toward Monterey. Drive 7.33 miles on Hwy 68 to the Laguna Seca Recreation Area entrance on the **right**.
