California Coasters Chapter Standing Rules Revised by the Board of Directors

On January 8, 2019 the Board of Directors met during the Indio Rally to discuss and vote on ten proposed changes to the Standing Rules. The Fourteenth Revision to the Standing Rules included a provision to allow the Board to vote by mail, email or other electronic means, eliminated three elected Board of Directors positions (2nd Vice President, the second Director and the Assistant Wagon Master), added a provision for the Treasurer to include a line item of profit or loss with the monthly financial report on completion of each rally, eliminated the Secret Sheriff fundraising activity at rallies and two minor errors in the text.

The Fourteenth Revision to the Standing Rules was unanimously approved by the Board of Directors on January 8, 2019. A copy of the Standing Rules with an Effective Date of January 8, 2019 is provided for your information and file as an attachment with your February/March Chatter.


