● RAINBOW JELLO

- 7 small boxes of various different jello
- 1 large container of sour cream
- 9x13" pan



- Mix 1 box of jello with 1 1/3 C of hot water. Follow directions on box for mixing. Pour all but 1/3 cup of prepared jello into dish and harden.
