

Neon Circus - Brooks & Dunn Tribute







Day Passes

\$15 per adult, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday, 12 and under free. Day passes will be sold at Fullenwider Lobby, the Arrival Area, and other gates as needed. Day passes include access to Vendors, Display RVs and exhibits, seminars, ice cream socials, Coffee Hour, At the Hop! Parade, and the Pet Extravaganza. Note that not all attractions are open on Wednesday. Day pass parking Thu-Sat will be on Oasis St. south of Dr. Carreon Blvd. Trams will run to the center of the grounds. Day Passes allow you to stay on Rally grounds until 5:00 pm. On Friday you can attend the Ladies' Social by purchasing a \$10.00 ticket.

FMCA members can stay for the evening entertainment for an additional \$25 per person.

REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- Open **<u>Campfires</u>** are prohibited.
- Flying of **<u>quadcopters</u>**, **<u>drones</u>**, or any unmanned air vehicle, is strictly prohibited.
- **Generator** hours are 7:00 am to 10:00 pm for those not parked in the electric area. A Full Generator Area is available for those needing generator power 24 hours/day.
- Display **Parking/Disabled Placards** in your RV windshield or window at all times. Place the parking hanger tag on car or truck interior mirror while on the grounds. Do not park tow vehicles or toweds where they might obstruct other vehicles.
- **Disability Scooters** are allowed in the RV display, Exhibitor, and Seminar areas. Other motorized vehicles are prohibited in these areas.
- **<u>Smoking</u>** is not allowed in any of the fairground buildings nor near the food area.
- **<u>Tailgate Sales</u>** The display of advertisements or items for sale outside your RV is not permitted. A "For Sale" sign inside your RV window is permitted.
- <u>Street Closures</u> Do not violate the street closure barriers. If ignored, you could be cited. They are there for your protection and the safe crossing of RVs from arrival to parking.
- **<u>Electricity</u>** if purchased at the time you registered will be indicated on your windshield placard included in your rally credentials. If you do not have a placard indicating you have paid for electricity, your electric cord will be disconnected and you will be subject to expulsion from the rally without a refund. Those in the Electric Areas are not permitted to run their generators.
- <u>Pets</u>, excluding service animals, are not allowed in any of the buildings nor near Food Booths. All pets are to be kept on a leash or in a pen at all times. *Please pick up after your pet.* 24 Hour Emergency Pet Hospital: (760) 342-4711
- Wear your **<u>Rally Badge</u>** at all times on the grounds. This is your admittance to rally activities including Exhibits. We encourage you to wear your rally badge when eating or shopping in town.
- **Dump Station** is located West of Gate 9. See map on page 50.
- There are no <u>Water</u> deliveries on the fairgrounds during the rally.
- **Propane** is available off-site. Get details at the Information Desk.
- For <u>Holding Tank Pump Out Service</u> call Burrtec Waste & Recycling Service: (760) 340-2113.
- If you have **Facility problems** at the rally, contact Co-Rally Master Bob Golk. He can be reached by anyone with a radio or at (661) 599-3548. Please do not contact Fairgrounds personnel.

STAYING AFTER THE RALLY?

The fairgrounds will allow RVs to stay on the grounds **<u>Sunday only</u>** for \$25. Temporary Electricity will shut off Sunday AM. Must be out on Monday Jan 13. Go to the Co-Rally Master's RV across from Taj Mahal and see Debbie Golk on Sunday Jan 12 to sign-up and pay (cash or check only - make checks payable to WMHA).






